But meanwhile, all the feedback I've received has been extremely positive and it's clear that people were delighted at the chance to get together in person, and really appreciated all the sessions. Many thanks to Susan Olsburgh for bringing us her Poetry Please group as a joint session with Voices; to our presenters; and to Elana for all her hard work to make the event a success.


Bob Findysz, our new Secretary, and Julian Alper, our new newsletter editor, have both started off so smoothly that you'd scarcely notice there's been a change! Congratulations to both of them. And Julian, as President-Elect, is also working with me to make this next change-over, at the end of June, as smooth as possible. Julian will then have two Voices email accounts: newsletter.voices@gmail.com for everything connected with the newsletter, and president.voices@gmail.com (which I'll hand over to him) for everything connected with running Voices Israel. ***Please do remember to send to the right one*** – it makes life so much easier!

Meanwhile Dina and I have been working hard on producing the 2024 Anthology. A couple of days ago I sent out a pdf for proofreading to everyone who has a poem in it. **Please send any needed corrections in to me by June 5th** (a week after receiving it). Production of the anthology is of course entirely separate from the role of President and Julian will be relieved to know that I'll continue doing it: he won't have a third hat to wear!

The memorial chapbook for Judih Weinstein Haggai z"l is also ready to roll. We'll be printing and distributing it together with the anthology. I've had a few enquiries about acceptance of late, which led me to think that we must not have sent out the acceptance/rejection notices. On checking, however, I see they all went out around March 12th. Perhaps we missed a few or perhaps a few poets missed the notice. If anyone is still unsure whether one or more of their poems were accepted, do contact me.

Finally: the start of the Reuben Rose Poetry Competition is just around the corner – it opens on July 15th. Last year we raised the fees and the prizes, and are debating why we only got two-thirds of the usual number of poems. Was it because we're all depressed by the war? (The Anthology also got fewer entries than usual). Was it because we raised the fees, even though we raised the prizes more? In any case, for this year we're adjusting both fees and prizes to somewhere between where they originally were, and where they were last year – the amount we can give out in prizes depends to a large extent on the amount we receive in entry fees, we aim to at least cover costs which we didn't manage to do last year. So we can't offer higher prizes without raising the entry fees at least a little. We're also trying out the idea of having more than one Third Prize. Details will be on the Reuben Rose section of the website Real Soon Now.

CALLS FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Israel Association of Writers in English (IAWE) will be accepting submissions from citizens and residents of Israel for the 31st issue of *arc*, its annual literary journal, until September 1st, 2024. The theme for *arc 31* is "The Phoenix". "The Phoenix" is a theme with a very broad canvas to explore:

- We are looking for poems that make us sit up and take note.
- We are looking for language that is innovative, striking and imaginative.
- We are looking for insight, courage; a step out of your comfort zone to explore experiences that are personal and characterize our zeitgeist.

The editor, Mike Stone, will consider original, unpublished poetry and short stories in English. You do not have to be a member of IAWE to submit your work.

Submission guidelines:

Submit 1-3 poems no longer than 150 lines in all, or prose of no more than 1,500 words, together with your name and contact details all in a single file in Word format, and email to: iawearc31submissions@gmail.com. Do not submit more than one file. Please use Times New Roman, font 12, single spacing for poems and double spacing for prose.

Deronda Review - Annual reading period is from May 15 to July 15, 2024. This time the theme is "trust" - chiefly trust among us, fellow-humans. E-mail submissions to derondareview@gmail.com.
